Mission: To provide a safe, nurturing and diverse community that fosters an innovative and engaging learning environment for children, families and staff.

Food Service: Hot catered lunch. Morning and Afternoon snacks.

Organization and Operation: The Center is a private non-profit corporation. A Board of Directors oversees management and controls funds. An Executive Director for the Center runs the day-to-day operations and reports to the Board. In addition parent involvement is highly encouraged and parents may drop by the center any time of day.

Wait List: The Center operates the waitlist on a priority system. First priority goes to children with siblings enrolled in the center with a parent working at a sponsoring agency. Second priority goes to children with siblings enrolled in the center. Third priority goes to children with parents working at one of the sponsoring agencies. Fourth priority goes to other federal government employees. Fifth priority goes to general population.
